

College of Southern Idaho Golden Girls Dance Team

The College of Southern Idaho is pleased to welcome you to our upcoming Dance Team Tryouts. The tryouts will be held on both the dates listed (usually Saturday) in the College of Southern Idaho Gym. An all-black dance attire is to be worn for the tryout, dance shoes must be worn. No bare feet or hard soled shoes will be allowed on the floor.

Applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria: dance ability, technique, knowledge and execution of individual and tryout routines, posture, splits, ability to learn quickly, appearance and showmanship.

AUDITIONS ARE CLOSED AUDITIONS. Observers will be asked to leave. Each participant will be required to perform a 30 second (approximate) routine of her own in any chosen dance genre - jazz, ballet, lyrical, hiphop or contemporary. (This is a routine that you bring with you, ready to perform at the tryout.)

Each applicant must bring the following forms completed and signed:

- Golden Girl application,
- Knowledge of Liability
- Evidence of Insurance

*The applicant WILL NOT be allowed to participate in any aspect of the clinic or tryouts without these being signed and turned into Coach Julie Wright before the clinic begins. Each dancer who is selected to be a member of the CSI Golden Girls Dance Team will receive a scholarship.

Scholarship amounts are listed on our website These scholarship amounts will be applied to the team members' tuition balance as a tuition credit – and must be “accepted” by said team member through the MYCSI link.

To be a Dance Team member you must be a full time student of 12 or more credits for the school year (Fall and Spring semester) and maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA. Team members will be asked to follow the CSI Athletics Code of Conduct. A general contract will be issued to all team members for signatures. A physical will be required to keep on file. This physical will be kept on record for two years.

We expect those auditioning to be in *top physical condition*. Because of the heavy physical demands on dancers. Strength, conditioning and flexibility are necessary to reduce the potential for injury. An additional DANC Jazz2 class will be required by all team members to register for. Modern and Ballet classes are also encouraged, in addition to Golden Girls class period. CSI offers an Associate's Degree in Dance!
